Township of Parana Hundred not named County not named and delineated in the Public Map deposited in the Survey Office at Adelaide and in the Plan in the margin hereof together with all Timber Minerals and Appurtenances To Hold unto the said Charles Nicholas Collison

Heirs and Assigns for ever In witness whereof I the said Governor have hereunto set my hand and the Public Seal of the said Province at Adelaide this twenty eighth day of October

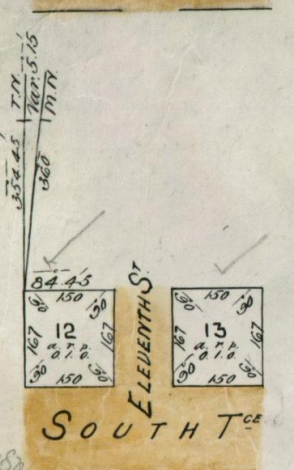
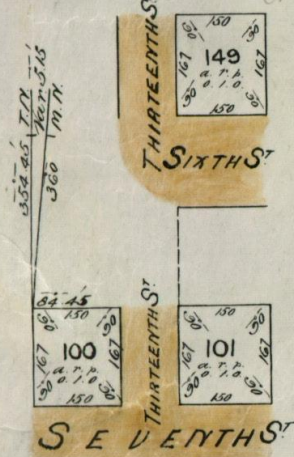
