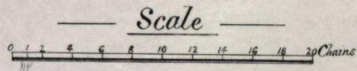
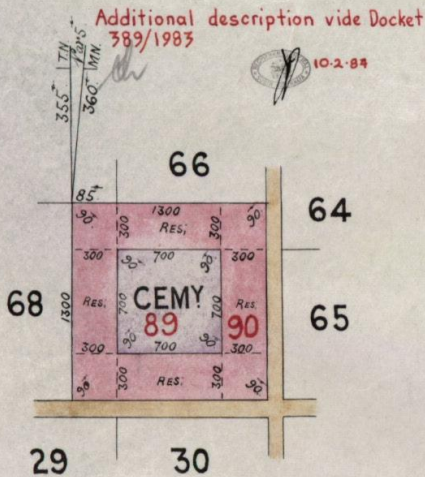

In trust to permit and suffer the said piece of land to be used at all times as a Public Cemetery Subject to the provisions of an Act of the Parliament of South Australia passed in the Twenty-fifth and Twenty-sixth Years of the Reign of her present Majesty intitled "An Act for the Regulation of Cemeteries" Except and always reserved unto Her Majesty Her Heirs and Successors all gold on or under the surface of the said land with full liberty of ingress egress and regress at all times to and for Her Majesty Her Heirs and Successors and to and for the Commissioner of Crown Lands and Immigration for the time being and all persons thereunto authorized by Her Majesty Her Heirs or Successors or by the said Commissioner with or without horses and other cattle carts or other carriages laden or unladen engines machinery and all necessary implements and things into upon and from the said land to view survey search dig for work store carry away sell and dispose of the said gold And also for the purposes aforesaid to erect steam engines and other machinery with buildings necessary thereto and to sink pits make wagon ways and use all other inventions and means for draining sinking storing leading carrying away selling and disposing of such gold doing or suffering to be done as little damage as possible to the surface of the said land and paying to the said Frank Wilkinson, Ronald Ewen Mc Donald, John Napier, George Tyler White, and John James Doig. fair and reasonable compensation for damage to the surface of the said land such compensation to be determined by valuation in manner provided by section 192 of "The Crown Lands Consolidation Act 1886" In witness whereof I the said Governor have hereunto set my hand and the public seal of the said Province at Adelaide this seventh day of July One Thousand Eight Hundred and eighty seven
