Know All Men by these Presents that I Sir William Francis Drummond Jerbois Major General in Her Majesty's Army Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the Province of South Australia and its Dependencies in consideration of the sum of two pounds and fifteen shillings

paying to the Treasurer of the said Province on behalf of Her Majesty paid by John Johns of Adelaide

do hereby in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty Grant unto the said John Johns

Section of land containing One acre

be the same a little more or less and numbered 141 situated in the Township of Parma County of Adelaide

and delineated in the Public Maps deposited in the Survey Office at Adelaide and in the Plan in the margin hereof together with all Timber Minerals and Appurtenances To Hold unto the said John Johns

Heirs and Assigns for ever In witness whereof I the said Governor have hereunto set my hand and the Public Seal of the said Province at Adelaide this twentieth day of October

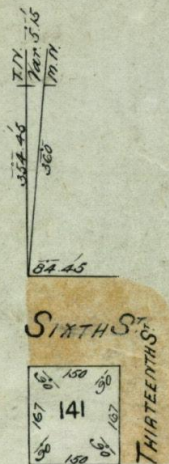
