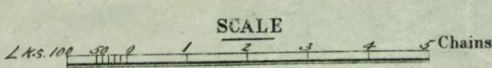
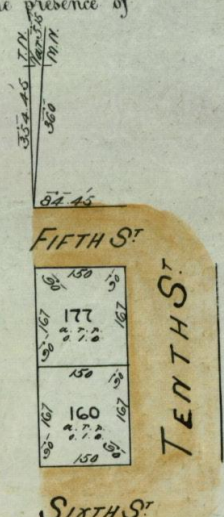

Hers and Assigns for ever In witness whereof I the said Governor have hereunto set my hand and the Public Seal of the said Province at Adelaide this twenty sixth day of October One thousand Eight hundred and nineteen

Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of Thomas Brown I acknowledge to have received from the above mentioned Edward Phillips Meredith the before mentioned sum of thirteen pounds
