Both Arthur and Ethel are buried in the Orroroo Cemetery. Arthur ran the Farina Post Office from 1939 until he enlisted in World War Two.
- 9. Muriel Elsie (Muzz) Chapman was born on 9 October 1920 in Marree. In 1942, Muriel took over running the Farina Post Office after her brother Arthur enlisted in World War Two. Muriel died on 14 January 2014 and was buried in the Farina Cemetery with her parents.
