JERVOIS, Major-General in Her Majesty's

WHEREAS by the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, it
is amongst other things enacted, that the Governor
might, by Proclamation to be published in the *Government
Gazette*, dedicate, in such manner as might seem best for
the public interests, any Crown lands for any public building

(not being intended for ecclesiastical purposes): Now, there-
fore, I, the Governor aforesaid, in pursuance of the provisions
of the above recited Act, do hereby proclaim and declare that
the Crown lands described in the Schedule hereto, shall, from
the date hereof, be reserved and dedicated for public purposes
for a Post Office and Telegraph Station at Farina Town, in
addition to allotment 393 in said Town:—

SCHEDULE REFERRED TO.

Comprising the whole of allotment 394, situate in Farina
Town, Government Gums, and bounded on the north by the
southern boundary of allotment 423; on the east by the
western boundary of allotment 395; on the south by the
northern side of First-street; and, on the west by the eastern
boundary of allotment 393.

Given under my hand and the public seal of the said
province, at Adelaide, this fourth day of December,
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and seventy-eight, and in the forty-second year of
