SYSTEM OF MARKING.

- 1. White Disc on Figure = Bull 4 pts.
- 2. Black Disc waved twice across Target and placed on Shot Hole = Inner ... 3 pts.
- 3. Black Disc revolved and placed on Shot Hole = Magpie
- 4. Black Disc passed up and down Left Side of Target and placed on Shot Hole = Outer 1 pt.
 - * In SNAPSHOOTING practice an Outer has no numerical value, but is recorded as a "Hit."

On Elementary Target (not Figure Target) an Outer = 2 points.

In view of possible wet weather, scores will be entered in ordinary pencil and inked in on the Same Day.

INSTRUCTIONS.


- 1. Every soldier must qualify in this course, and fire a minimum of 80 rounds service ammunition before embarkation.
 - 2. Those who reach the qualifying standard in Parts I. and II. will be classed as "Qualified."
- 3. Soldiers who fail to reach the standard in any practice or practices in Part I. will, after completing Part I., repeat the practice or practices in which they failed; those who fail to qualify in Part II. will repeat all the practices of Part II. Men who fail at the second test will be marked on their record cards "Failed, detailed for fatigues." When they reach the front, if not in the meantime qualified, they can be told off to do fatigue work for those who can shoot.
- 4. The practices mentioned below will be conducted in accordance with the principles laid down in Musketry Regulations, Part I., 1909 (Reprint 1914), and Supplementary Instructions for Musketry Course A.M. Forces.
- 5. Men who reach the qualification standard will be required to repeat practices 3 and 6, or carry out individual field practices before embarkation.
- 6. Squadron, Battery, Company Commanders, &c., will furnish a statement to their Commanding Officers at conclusion of course, certifying that all members of their units have completed. They will at the same time, bring under notice the number and names of those who have failed and are recommended for discharge.


