I regret to advise you that **your brother, No. 3107 Private Gerald R. Gill, 8th Battalion**, has been reported wounded,

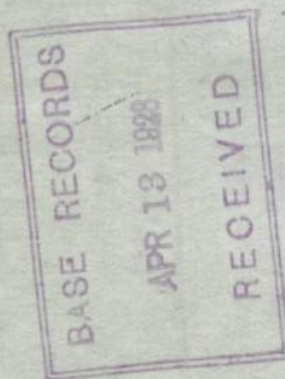
