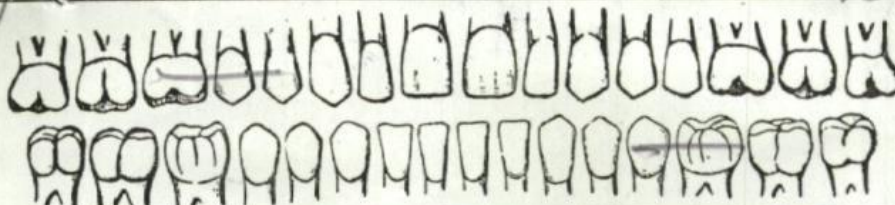

NOTES.—(i.)
