
Dear Sir

Thank you for your help.

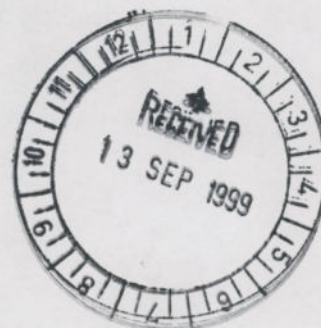
